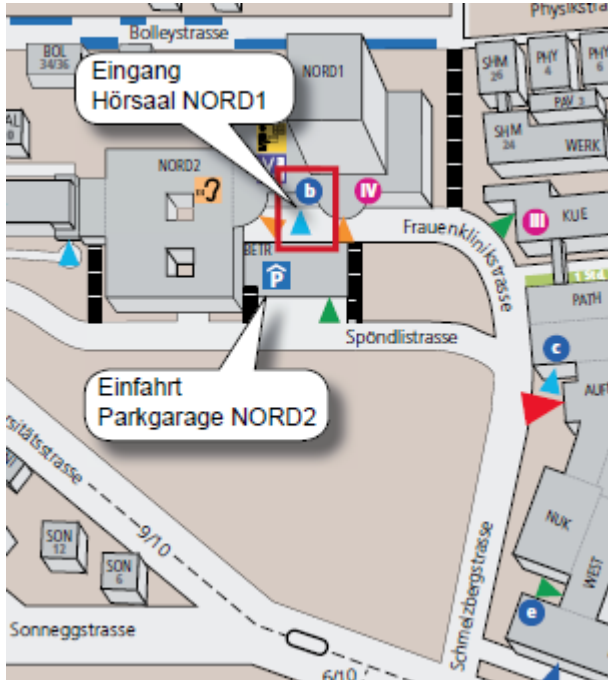


How to find the congress venue

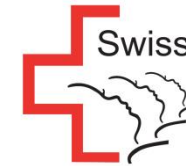


Public transport:

- Tram 6 => direction Zoo
 - Exit at «ETH/Universitätsspital»

By car:

- Follow the signboarding «Universitätsspital»

Challenges in perinatal and neonatal infectious diseases

The upcoming annual meeting of the Swiss Society of Neonatology will be devoted to perinatal and neonatal infections. Apart from the members of the Neonatal Society, we have invited representatives of the Paediatric Infectious Diseases Group Switzerland (www.PIGS.ch) to join this meeting, and we are going to present five sessions on this important topic.

The meeting will focus on vertical infections, neonatal sepsis in Switzerland and on controversies about microbial screening and antimicrobial use in neonatal medicine; a discussion with a panel of experts will follow the two conferences on the latter issue, presented by Prof. Christoph Bühler from Berlin, and Dr Martin Stocker from Lucerne. Once again, young Swiss neonatologists and paediatricians will be given the opportunity to present their research projects, either as a short report at the beginning of the scientific program, or as a poster discussed during lunch break. Prizes for the best short report and the best poster will be awarded at the end of the meeting.
